RE: MEMORANDUM ON KENYA NATIONAL BUDGET ESTIMATE/ FINANCE BILL AS PRIORITY IN 2024/2025 BUDGET

The humble memorandum of Migori community members; the memorandum presenters herein whose address for purposes of this memorandum shall be as stated above within the Republic of Kenya RESPECTFULLY state as follows:

- 1. That we are community members of Migori County;
- 2. That we are adult taxpayers of sound mind, and registered voters in Migori County;
- 3. That we are interested parties in this matter, and have the right to present this memorandum.

FACTS GIVING RISE TO THE MEMORANDUM

- I. **Violation of Constitutional Rights**: provisions within the budget estimates and finance bill directly contravene Articles in the Kenyan Constitution on safeguarding children's rights (such as Articles 53 and 55, which mandate the state's duty to ensure child protection and welfare), this is a solid ground for our objection. The budget estimates and finance bill proposes budget cuts and reallocations that significantly undermine funding for education, healthcare, and social services critical for children, the budget estimates and finance bill violates constitutional mandates.
- 2. **Inconsistency with International Treaties**: Kenya is a signatory to various international treaties, such as the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child. Provisions in the budget estimates and finance bill potentially reduce the government's ability to fulfill its obligations under these treaties—such as commitments to ensure access to education, health, and protection from economic exploitation—these are our grounds for objection.
- 3. Lack of Public Participation: The Kenyan Constitution underscores the importance of public participation in legislative processes. The development, drafting, and approval of the budget estimates and finance bill bypassed meaningful public engagement—particularly from stakeholders focused on child welfare—this procedural flaw is our basis for challenging the provisions therein.
- 4. Adverse Socio-economic Impacts on Children: Specific measures within the budget estimates and finance bill, like new taxes and removal of subsidies on essential goods and services, which could disproportionately affect children, especially those from vulnerable communities. These measures would significantly increase the cost of living, negatively impact access to nutrition, health care, and education, and consequently, undermine children's rights to survival, development, and protection.

- 5. **Insufficient Protections for Vulnerable Groups:** the budget estimates and finance bill lack adequate provisions to protect or bolster support for vulnerable children, such as those with disabilities, orphans, or those from low-income families. These are significant oversights and a basis for objection.
- 6. **Undermining Sustainable Development Goals:** These provisions would potentially thwart progress toward achieving Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) related to children's welfare (such as SDG I: No Poverty, SDG 2: Zero Hunger, SDG 3: Good Health and Well-being, and SDG 4: Quality Education) are our grounds for objection, given the government's commitments to these international goals.

LEGAL AND CONSTITUTIONAL FOUNDATION OF THE MEMORANDUM

- I. **The Constitution of Kenya**, **2010**: The supreme law of Kenya sets out the principles of public finance in Chapter Twelve. Key principles include:
- **Public Participation**: The Constitution mandates public involvement in financial matters. Any finance bill should undergo public consultation processes. Omission of this could be seen as a contradiction to constitutional mandates.
- **Equitable Sharing of National Revenue**: The Constitution requires that revenue raised nationally is shared equitably among the national and county governments. A finance bill and budget estimates that disregards this principle may be contested.
- Oversight and Accountability in Budget Management: The Constitution tasks Parliament with overseeing national revenue and its expenditure. A finance bill and budget estimates that potentially undermine this oversight could raise constitutional concerns.
- 2. **The Public Finance Management Act, 2012**: This Act provides for the effective management of public finances by the national and county governments. Any provisions within the Finance Bill and budget estimates 2024/2025 that could undermine prudent and transparent management of finances would be in contradiction to this act.
- 3. **The Tax Procedures Act**: This Act sets out the procedures for the administration of taxes. The Budget estimates and Finance Bill should align with this act in terms of tax collection, remittance, and penalties for non-compliance.
- 4. **Equal Opportunities and Anti-Discrimination Laws**: Specifically, legislation like the Persons with Disabilities Act and the Children's Act. Thee Budget estimates and Finance bill should not indirectly or directly discriminate against any group and should make provisions considering the vulnerable in society.

REASONS WHEREFORE our humble prayers are as follows:

I. Request for Reconsideration/Amendment: THAT, we call on Parliament to reconsider or amend sections of the budget estimates and finance bill that adversely affect child well-being safeguards. This would ensure that all financial policies or tax reforms

proposed are vetted for their impact on children's rights and protection frameworks before enactment.

- 2. **Injunction**: THAT, the Budget estimates and Finance bill has passed certain critical stages and since its nearing enactment, we might consider seeking a court injunction to halt its implementation until a thorough review of its impacts on child well-being can be conducted.
- 3. **Judicial Review**: THAT, we petition for a judicial review of the budget estimates and finance bill since the process towards its approval or its contents are in violation of the Kenyan Constitution, especially articles pertaining to children's rights and welfare.
- 4. **Policy Guidelines Request**: THAT, we ask for the issuance of detailed guidelines by the relevant ministries (such as the Ministry of Labour and Social Protection) on how the budget estimates and finance bill's provisions will be implemented in a manner that ensures the protection and promotion of child welfare is not compromised.
- 5. **Budgetary Allocations**: THAT, we request for increased budgetary allocations for social protection programs aimed at mitigating any negative impacts the budget estimates and finance bill may have on children. These calls for increased investment in education, health care, and social services for vulnerable children.
- 6. **Monitoring and Evaluation Framework**: THAT, we propose the establishment or strengthening of a monitoring and evaluation framework to track the impact of the budget estimates and finance bill on child well-being on a regular basis.
- 7. **Public Consultation and Participation**: THAT, we call for enhanced public participation and consultation processes, especially involving child welfare organizations, in the crafting of future budget estimates and finance bills, to ensure a comprehensive understanding and incorporation of child welfare concerns as.
